

2023 Farm Bill Priorities



The National Grocers Association (NGA) represents 21,000 independent community grocers and wholesalers across the United States. Independent community grocers account for 33 percent of all grocery sales, exceeding \$250 billion, and more than 1 million American jobs.

Expand Access to Snap in Grocery Stores

- Maintain SNAP Choice allowing consumers to make their own food decisions.
- **Expand online SNAP** and provide technical assistance for retailers to participate.
- Create incentives for grocers to expand into rural communities.
- Oppose major program changes like block granting or a government-run food distribution service.
- Expand SNAP access for Puerto Rico by shifting away from a block grant.

Bolster Healthy Foods Purchased With Snap in Grocery Stores

- **Expand nutrition incentives** by streamlining access at grocery stores through EBT cards.
- ♠ Increase funding for the Healthy Food Financing Initiative to support grocers in carrying healthier foods.
- ★ Modernize SNAP-Ed to reach more SNAP participants where they are.

Protect Retailers From Burdensome Fees and Regulations

- ♦ Oppose taxing grocers for participating in SNAP by allowing processing, interchanges, or others EBT fees.
- ♠ Innovate payment modalities to ensure the program is keeping up with payment technologies.
- ♦ Protect the equal treatment of all SNAP participants.
- Protect the definition of authorized SNAP retailer.
- ♦ Oppose SNAP data reporting requirements to protect retailer privacy.
